Service Limitations

Claymont Health and Rehabilitation Center, (hereafter referred to as “Facility”), cannot care for every applicant who wishes to receive services. The Facility has certain limitations due to size, location, composition, staffing and equipment. The facility cannot care for residents with any of the following diagnosis and/or identified problems:

- Ventilator patients
- Persons who are registered sex offenders
- Persons with unmanaged major mental illness diagnosis
- Persons with unmanaged drug or alcohol dependence
- Persons receiving chemotherapy or other biologicals that may require special monitoring
- Persons who are pregnant

Residents and /or Resident Representatives are required to disclose all conditions and diagnosis prior to/or upon an admission to our facility, and we will discuss these service limitations with you upon admission. If you fail to disclose any of the above conditions at the time of admission or one of the above conditions is identified or develops after admission, Claymont Health and Rehabilitation Center may seek to discharge you if we can no longer meet your needs.
